What is Super Summer?

Super Summer is a discipleship/evangelism leadership conference designed to provide qualitative spiritual growth and help develop student leadership in Mississippi churches. Super Summer is designed specifically for students who personally have a desire to grow spiritually. Students not only learn, but they also are challenged to share and live out their faith. Students must complete requirements in order to participate in Super Summer.

Super Summer is designed to build on the previous years, however, students who don't go all the way through still can participate in the schools designed especially for them. Students are divided into schools based on the number of years they have attended. Students spend the majority of their time in these schools where they are taught curriculum focused on the teaching principle for that year. Students are taught by Servant Staff, youth ministers and other church leaders that are selected by the Super Summer Planning Team. Students also participate in small groups led by trusted college leaders that have been selected to serve.

What are the Schools?

Students are divided into schools based on the number of years they have attended. Each year the curriculum builds on the previous years and is based on the acronym LEAD (leadership, evangelism, apologetics, and discipleship). Students will focus on one of these topics as they move through each year and school.

Year One: Discipleship • Year Two: Evangelism • Year Three: Leadership • Year Four: Apologetics • Year Five: Missional Living

REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL SUPER SUMMER APPLICANTS

1. Completed the 8th grade but not yet in college.
2. Agrees to attend all Super Summer sessions and participate in all activities.
3. Must be a faithful, baptized believer.
4. Demonstrates leadership qualities and is a growing Christian.
5. Live and actively share faith consistently.
6. Devoted to prayer. Committed to purity and abstinence. Totally drug-free.
7. At least **75% attendance** at weekly church and student ministry events (Sunday School & Wednesday Nights).
Attendance will be recorded from August 28 – June 28 (33/44 weeks).
8. Participates in student ministry major events (D-Now, retreats, camps, etc.).
9. Share personal testimony with youth group.
 - a. Meet w/ Jack at least 2 weeks prior to sharing testimony.
 - b. Submit “My Testimony” sheet to Jack at least 1 week prior to sharing testimony.
10. Involved in a “small group” discipleship study or an accountability group (other than Sunday School).
11. Scripture Memory Verses (*from approved translation*)
 - a. 1st year – 1 John 1
 - b. 2nd year – 1 John 1–2 **All 2nd year and above students will*
 - c. 3rd year – 1 John 1–3 *memorize 1 John 1-2.*
 - d. 4th year – 1 John 1–4
 - e. 5th year – 1 John 1–5
12. Journal how you are growing in your walk with Christ (prayer, scripture memorization, struggles, joy, etc.). **Due June 25.**
13. Seeks to penetrate culture with the gospel (involved in church outreach, campus ministry, missions, community service).
14. Must have 2 recommendations from people who know them outside of the church (teachers, coaches, employers, etc.). **Due February 1.**
15. Second year & above students write an essay (100 words) which expresses your level of commitment to Christ and how you are involved in leadership in your church and community. This should be given to your youth pastor. **Due October 30.**
16. Complete 2 spiritual assessments (1 Fall, 1 Spring) toward the end of each semester to track progress in spiritual growth and leadership.

****Failure to complete requirements by February 28, 2023 will result in the student being unable to attend Super Summer 2023.***
